This years event was well attended and brings high expectations for the 2015 event. Â Proceeds from this event were a part of a donation to the Galion City Schools Campus wear fund. This fund provides vouchers to aid less fortunate families for clothing that meets school dress

will be featured along with food pairings that might accompany each wine. This has proven to be a fun time and is not restricted to Galion Alumni, but is open to any one of legal age willing to purchase a ticket for the sampling. Â Proceeds are intended for the Campus Wear Fund.Â

This year, the Association decided to revive

the 300 Club drawings for the home football and basket ball games. These drawings were previously sponsored by the Galion Boosters Club. For those not familiar with the way these drawings work, here is a brief description. There are 300 tickets sold at \$20.00 each. At each home football or

basketball game, two tickets are drawn and the purchasers of those tickets receive \$100.00 dollars each. The tickets drawn are then deposited back into the pool of tickets and are eligible to be drawn again at the next drawing. Each ticket has a 1 in 300 or 1

in 299 chance of being drawn if all of the tickets have been sold. Â Total income from all sources including the Wine Tasting, 300 Club, membership dues, donations and account interest amounted to \$5449.78.Â

A Cash donations to the Galion City School

System this year included \$ 1500.00 to the Campus Wear Fund, \$2001.00 for Connections Weekend HOF expenses and \$500.00 to Galion Band Parents for a band trip. . \hat{A} Money was also spent to promote the Association through ads in the Drama Department program and Yearbook. Expense Items this year included Post Office Box fees and postage and office supplies. \hat{A} \hat{A} Total expenses came to \$5618.41, just a little more than we brought in.

The Galion Alumni Association is a

participating member of the Galion Connections Weekend Committee. Â This committee was established to bring together the several organizations that contribute to the Galion City Schools in one form or another. Â The committee consists of members of the Galion City Schools.

Galion Alumni Association, Galion Community Foundation, Galion Community Education Foundation, The Galion Tiger Alumni Band, Galion Community Center/YMCA, Galion Booster Club and Galion Parent Teacher Organizations. Â This Committee is responsible for the production of the Galion Connections Weekend. Â This weekend features a Thursday, Homecoming Bonfire (Weather permitting), Friday,

Career Day for High School and Middle School students and the Homecoming Game in the evening. Saturday features a Kiwanis sponsored Pancake Breakfast, and the Hall of Fame Banquet. The Alumni Association plays a large role in the Hall of Fame event. You can check out the accomplishments of the Hall of Fame Members by using the Inductee Links locate in the right column. Â All of these events are open to the public and are not restricted to Alumni.

Since the creation of the Association in 2004, there has been only one significant project that required solicitation of funds. That was the Entryway Project. Â Alumni responded and the result is on display at the entrance to the Galion City School Campus on Portland Way North.
