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Hall of Fame Nominations - For 2018, applications will be accepted beginning March 1st and the deadline for applications is June 1st. Paul Kim is already approved for 2018, Horace Freese & George Guins were also recommended. Mr. Egbert Freese also has application information on file. The Selection Committee will meet by June 1sth. Hezzie Chorba may also be nominated, he works in Hollywood as an animator; Ed Snyder may also be in the nomination group as former Galion educator; NEW entry (found in the files afterthe meeting) Michael Jokerst, posthumously, class of 1975, nominated by BIII Mechling. Mike was VP of Productivity Optimization @ Nationwide Insurance & Principal of CFO Leadership Consulting in Columbus.

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Dinner Banquet - Sandy contacted Pioneer Culinary Arts Program but they were unable to help us in October; AVITA was then contacted and Sandy will continue to work w/Wade Cramer, selecting menus in July;
